Currently, 55.4% of the 42,754 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3%, renter occupied; and 12.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 42,188 housing units in the area - 58.4% owner occupied, 31.9% renter occupied, and 9.7% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 0.59%.
